An undergraduate degree with an overall 2.75 GPA from a regionally accredited institution with at least four quantitative courses that average a 3.0 GPA. (Please attach a copy of your unofficial transcript).

A minimum of 3 years of professional experience with increasing levels of responsibility. (Please attach a copy of your professional resume)

An earned professional credential such as a CPA, CFP, PE license, CMA, CFE, CIA, etc. OR a graduate degree from an accredited program. (Please attach a copy of your credential or unofficial transcript as appropriate, and copy of your resume)

Please note the following:

- Admitted students may be required to take additional preparatory coursework or learning modules depending on their academic and/or professional background.
- GMAT/GRE waivers are not guaranteed to those who meet one of the above criteria. The applicant's entire application packet will be considered when a GMAT/GRE waiver decision is made.
