GMAT/GRE waiver requests will be considered for MBA applicants who meet one of the following waiver criteria and must be requested when completing the application online. Please select one:

An undergraduate BSBA major or other AACSB Business major with an overall 3.5 GPA and a 3.75 cumulative GPA within the major (defined as upper-level courses in business). If you select this, please attach a copy of your unofficial transcript.

A minimum of five years of professional experience with increasing levels of responsibility, **AND** an undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher, with at least four quantitative courses that average a 3.0 GPA. If you select this, please attach an unofficial copy of your transcript, and copy of your resume following these guidelines:

- Highlight professional accomplishments, management roles, and responsibilities that specifically require applied analytical skills.
- Include the number of people supervised, amount of budget managed, facility overseen, sales targets/goals met, and other quantifiable successes.

Four years of post-baccalaureate experience with an earned professional credential such as a CPA, CFP, PE license, CMA, CFE, CIA, etc. If you select this, please attach a copy of your professional credential and resume.

A graduate degree in a quantitative discipline from an accredited program or doctorate degree. If you select this, please attach a copy of your unofficial transcript.

Note: GMAT/GRE waivers are not guaranteed to those who meet one of the above criteria. The applicant's entire application packet will be considered when a GMAT/GRE waiver decision is made. All waivers that meet the requirements above will be forwarded to the CBA Graduate Petitions Committee for approval.
